Sumrall FFA wins national awards at convention

The Sumrall FFA was privileged to go to the 83rd National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana. The Farm Business Management Team, comprised of Tell Ford, Leslie Shields, and Chelsea Freyoux; the Horse Evaluation Team, comprised of Sam Newman, Alex Carlson, and Meagan Thrash; and Creed Speaker, Brooke Ingram, all received bronze. The Poultry Judging Team including Courtney Cooper, Hannah Roberts and Katie Patterson received silver, and was ranked 18th in the nation.

This is the first time any Sumrall FFA team has ranked in the top 20 in the nation. Hannah Roberts was awarded gold for top individual scoring, the first ever gold at Sumrall.

Eric Cooper, a former Sumrall student, also went with the group to receive his American Degree, which is the highest degree in the FFA that a member can be awarded.
